



Background and site description	Located in Taunton with easy access to the M5, A303, A38, A358, A361 routes, the site is freehold and sits in the shadow of the A358 that passes above the site along the western boundary.  The site has no internal vegetation and lies at the western end of a trading estate in the centre of Taunton. The site is bordered by broadleaved vegetation and the Bridgwater and Taunton Canal to the immediate north with residential dwellings beyond the canal, to west are allotments and to the south lies the Children's Wood/ Riverside Local Nature reserve (LNR) (see below).				
National Designations (SSSI, SAC, SPAs, RAMSARs and NPs) within 1km	The site is immediately adjacent to the Children's Wood/ Riverside LNR that is important for the habitat associated with the River Tone including grassy banks and berms, trees and a small area of woodland. The reserve is an important core and connective habitat for many bird species as well as bats, otters and invertebrates.
